Sask Sport Inc. Announces the August Athlete of the Month Award Recipient

Logan Campbell of Saskatoon is the recipient of the Sask Sport Inc. August Athlete of the Month Award. He was nominated by the Saskatchewan Sailing Clubs Association.

Campbell won a silver medal at the IFDS World Championships in Halifax, N.S., which featured 16 countries. As a result of Campbell's silver-medal performance, he and the rest of his crew (Paul Tingley and Scott Luttes) have qualified Canada for the Sonar class at the 2016 Paralympics in Brazil.

The other outstanding nominees for this month were:

- Bob Hudson, Para-Archery, Leoville – won silver at the Canadian National Archery Championships/Canadian Open and scored a 1337 at the FITA 1440 target, which qualifies him for the Para Pan Am Games.
- Colin Finnie, Horseshoe Pitching, Kenaston – placed first at the Canadian Championships and the qualifying Western Classic. Finished first at the Fall Frolic and was second at the Paddockwood event in Prince Albert.
- Auriel Bill and Amy Yule, Water Polo, Regina – members of the 18U Women's National Team that finished second at the Women's 18U World Championships. Was the team's first medal on the Junior World stage since 2003.
- Grant Wilkie, Lawn Bowling, Saskatoon – won gold at the U25 World Junior Cup Qualifier, which qualifies him for the U25 World Junior Championship. Won gold at the Canadian Championship Men's Triples. Won silver at the 2014 Canadian U25 Championships.
- Kylie Zirk, Canoe Kayak, Saskatoon – earned gold in the C1 Slalom event at the Minden Hills Open. Won gold (K1 Slalom) and silver (C1 Slalom Junior Women) medals at the Canadian Whitewater Championships, qualifying for the Junior and U23 World Championships.
- Jarret Kenke, Canoe Kayak, Saskatoon – won two gold medals at the Canadian Sprint Canoe-Kayak Championships (Junior Men K2 1000m, Junior Men K2 500m) and three silver medals (Junior Men K1 500m, Junior Men K1 1000m, Junior Men K2 200m). Results will likely earn Kenke a spot on the National Senior Development Team.
- Sara Murray, Athletics, Saskatoon – won gold at the National Youth Championships in the Women's U18 Heptathlon, establishing a Saskatchewan Athletics Youth Women's record. Part of the bronze-winning U18 Women's 4 X 100m Relay team.
