Sask Sport Inc. Announces the March Athlete of the Month Award Recipient

Brianne Theisen-Eaton of Humboldt is the recipient of the **Sask Sport Inc. March Athlete of the Month Award**. She was nominated by Saskatchewan Athletics.

Competing in the Heptathlon discipline at the International Association of Athletics Federations (IAAF) World Indoor Championships, Theisen-Eaton won a gold medal and established a new Saskatchewan Athletics and Athletics Canada open/senior women's indoor pentathlon record. She finished with a score of 4,881 in the event, which is made up of 60 metre hurdles, high jump, shot put, long jump and the 800m. Theisen-Eaton's Road to Rio continues with the upcoming Olympic Trials (Canadian Senior Championships) in July.

The other outstanding nominees for this month were:

- **Ronald Brandt, Saskatoon, Special Olympics (Snowshoeing)** – At the Special Olympics National Winter Games, he won gold in the 800m Snowshoe M4 Division and silver medals in the 400m Snowshoe M6 Division, 200m Snowshoe M6 Division and 100m Snowshoe M6 Division.
- **Regina Ript U19 Team, Regina, Ringette** – Won a silver medal at the Western Canadian Ringette Championships in the U19A division. Two of the team's athletes won all-star awards and the team also won the Team Relay Race in the skills competition;
- **Kenzie Priddell, Regina, Synchronized Swimming** – At the Synchro Saskatchewan National Qualifier Championships, she earned bronze medals for her senior solo technical routine and trio routine (along with teammates Kenzie Dahl and Emma New). Has qualified to compete in the 2016 Canadian Open National Synchronized Swimming Championships.
