### Sask Sport Inc. Announces the March Athlete of the Month Award Recipient

**Terry Livingstone** of Regina is the recipient of the **Sask Sport Inc. March Athlete of the Month Award**. He was nominated by Special Olympics Saskatchewan.

Livingstone won a gold medal in the 777 metre speed skating event at the Special Olympics World Winter Games in Austria. He also placed fourth in the 500m speed skating category.

The other outstanding nominees were:

- **Sherry Anderson's Canadian Senior Women's Curling Team, Saskatoon** – represented Saskatchewan at the Everest Canadian Senior Men's and Women's Curling Championships in Fredericton, NB, defeating Ontario 7-3 in the final. The team – consisting of Sherry Anderson (skip), Patricia Hersikorn (third), Brenda Goertzen (second) and Anita Silvernagle (lead) – will represent Canada at the 2018 World Senior Curling Championships.
- **Michael McGillivray, Regina, Swimming** – placed first in the 800m freestyle (14-15 boys) and broke the provincial record by more than 10 seconds at the Long Course Prairie Championships in Saskatoon, while also winning gold in the 1500m freestyle. He qualified for the Canadian World Trials in both events.
- **Julee Stewart, Regina, Baton Twirling** – finished second overall at the Congressional Cup in Maryland. Her second-place finish is the highest placing by a Canadian woman since the 2001 World Champion in 2001.
- **Astrid Nyame, Saskatoon, Athletics** – won a gold medal in the 60m hurdles at the USPORT Track and Field Championship in Edmonton while competing for the University of Saskatchewan Huskies. Was awarded the Diane Jones Award at the Huskie Track and Field Gala (most outstanding female athlete) and the Mary Ethel Cartwright Award (female athlete of the year) at the Huskie Athletics Banquet.
- **Bon Lowe, Saskatoon, Speed Skating** – was the overall champion at the Canada West Short Track Championships in Saskatoon. Finished first in the 400m, 1500m and 2000m and second in the 200m.
- **Adam Nazarali, Saskatoon, Fencing** – won a silver medal with Team Canada at the Junior Pan American Championships in Cuba. It's the highest that Canada has finished in the men's foil event at the championships.
