Sask Sport Inc. Announces the February Athlete of the Month Award Recipient

Graeme Fish of Moose Jaw is the recipient of the **Sask Sport Inc. February Athlete of the Month Award**. He was nominated by the Saskatchewan Amateur Speed Skating Association.

Fish won a bronze medal in the 5,000 metre and placed fourth in team pursuit at the World Junior Long Track Championships in Helsinki, Finland. It was his first international medal and there were 60 participants in his category.

The other outstanding nominees were:

- **Kenzie Priddell, Regina, Synchro** – won gold medals in the solo, duet and trio events at the Canadian University Synchronized Swimming League Western Championships in B.C. Won a bronze medal in the duo and trio event while finishing fourth in the solo event at the Canadian University Synchronized Swimming League National Championships in Montreal, Q.C.
- **Thomas Hasal, Saskatoon, Soccer** – competed with Team Canada at the CONCACAF U20 Men's Championships in San Jose, Costa Rica, recording one shut out. He is the first Saskatchewan youth male player to be called up to the national team in nearly 10 years. Started in all three of Canada's Classification Phase matches, posting a shut out during the team's 2-0 win against Antigua and Barbuda.
