Sask Sport Inc. Announces the February Athlete of the Month Award Recipient

Emily Clark of Saskatoon is the recipient of the **Sask Sport Inc. February Athlete of the Month Award**. She was nominated by Canadian Sport Centre Saskatchewan.

Clark competed in the 2018 Winter Olympic Games in Pyeongchang, South Korea, as a member of the Canadian women's ice hockey team. She played in all five games and had one goal and two assists as Canada won the silver medal.

The other outstanding nominees were:

- **University of Regina Cougars Senior Men's 4 x 200 metre Free Relay Team** – posted a provincial record time of 7:23.74 and won a bronze medal in the 4X200m freestyle at the U Sports Championships. It was the first relay medal in U of R history.
- **Linden Vey, Wakaw, Hockey** – had one assist in six games for Team Canada at the 2018 Winter Olympic Games, helping Canada win a bronze medal.
- **Mark McMorris, Regina, Snowboarding** – won a bronze in slopestyle and finished 10th in big air at the 2018 Winter Olympic Games.
