

SASKATOON ROWING CLUB: Club Coach Position

Position Overview

The Club Coach will be an enthusiastic and motivated individual with a strong background in the sport of rowing and knowledge of the equipment. The Club Coach will oversee all coaching aspects of the Junior Development, Senior and Masters athletes including development and programming while adhering to the club's high standards of athletic excellence and ensuring the safety of all rowers & equipment both on-site and while travelling.

The Club Coach is responsible to the President and Executive Committee of the Saskatoon Rowing Club

Start Date & Wage

- Coaching will begin April 1st, 2019 to September 15th, 2019 with possibility of extension.
- Pay will be \$18 per hour.

Preferred Qualifications and Skills

- Experience in Rowing is essential
- Learn to Row Coaching certification and/or High-Performance Coaching certification from RCA is an asset.
- Ability to work independently and accomplish tasks
- Valid Driver's license and power boat operator's license
- First aid and CPR (preferred)
- Mature and effective communication skills
- Positive attitude and ability to work with a variety of different skill levels

Responsibilities and Duties:

- Coach all abilities of rowers from graduating novice, to Junior Development to competitive Senior and Master rowers
- Coordination of the rowing activity schedules, regattas and other

competitions in co-operation with the administrative coordinator and other coaching staff

- Programming for each group of athletes and potentially individual programs if required
- Mentor under the High-Performance Coach for the delivery of rowing programs to high-performance athletes
- Attend and oversee athlete participation in regattas, boat loading and trailering
- Relay accommodation, vehicle rental, and other travel needs for competitions to Club Administrator in a timely fashion
- Manage the day-to-day equipment allocation among participating athletes in cooperation with Novice and Learn to Row coaches
- Maintain boathouse and equipment, notifying administration and Equipment Manager of necessary repairs, and assist with repair work
- Ensure all safety equipment is current and functional and work with administration on Emergency Action Plan and implementation
- Ensure all athletes understand the safety and Saskatoon Rowing Club guidelines and that all members are following guidelines
- Meet weekly with the club president to discuss equipment, program, coaching and other requirements
- Retain open dialogue with the Club administrator, Novice and Learn-To-Row coaching staff and Equipment Manager
- Foster a program of inclusiveness and respect
- Attend and present at club executive meetings upon request.
